**Think "Iditarod":** Camp Iditatusky is the Hiawatha District Winter Camporee and Klondike Derby. The Iditatusky is a race that will test Scout skills in winter survival mode.

Troops and Crews will race off in the morning with their Klondike sled filled with everything they might need to overcome any possible encounters. All Troops and Crews are welcome to step up to the challenge.

To survive this arduous journey, you will need to be on top of your Scouting skills. The trail is a brutal one; you will need your entire team involved to quickly assess the challenges along the way, devise a plan, and execute it to survive.

**Adult Roles:** Help with activities or follow your Scouts along the trail- but let them own their own experiences (observe and answer questions, but don't do anything for them- they'll lose opportunities for rewards on the trail). Ensure proper preparation of gear, including sled, prior to the event.

**Gear List:** Rope (for lashing and for rescue use), (6) 6' staves, (2) 3' staves, lunch materials (stove, matches, cook gear, eating gear, food, drink, cleaning gear), compass, first aid kit, tarp (min 8'x8'), neckerchiefs (2), patrol flags, anything else you believe may be necessary to take on the challenge.

**BSA REQUIREMENTS** Youth and adults must be BSA-registered to participate. Youth Protection requirements apply.
