As an Arrowman, I understand the lodge leadership is responsible for the supervision of the event in respect to maintaining discipline and security, and agree to the following **Code of Conduct**:

1. Observe the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and the Order of the Arrow Obligation.
2. Attend all planned general sessions and activities.
3. Confine trading and swapping to free periods and designated areas.
4. Be personally responsible for breakage, damage, or loss of property.
5. Observe quiet hours and lights out from midnight to 7 a.m.
6. Keep my quarters clean, my bed made and dispose of trash in the proper place.
7. Not change my officially assigned sleeping quarters without permission from headquarters.
8. Understand that the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs at the event will not be permitted and will result in immediate dismissal from the event. This standard shall apply to all youth and adult participants.
9. Comply with federal, state, and local laws, including those which prohibit the use of fireworks, firearms, and gambling. Infraction of these laws and regulations will be cause for immediate dismissal from the event.
10. Not be authorized to sell items at the event. I understand that the lodge trading post is the only source for purchasing items at the event.
11. At all times, be considerate guests of the camp and the council.
12. Follow the Boy Scouts of America's policy on smoking and observe all smoking restrictions.
13. All individuals under the age of 21 must remain at the event for its entire duration, unless prior arrangements have been made with lodge leadership, and written consent from a parent/guardian is on file with headquarters.
14. Individuals under the age of 18 are prohibited from driving to the event. Individuals under the age of 21 must have parental permission to ride with a driver under the age of 21.
