

Is any Special Equipment Needed? An equipment list will be sent to each participant after their reservation is received. Youth who participate in an active unit outdoor program probably already have the necessary personal equipment. A complete official Boy Scout or Venturing uniform is required. Each participant should make sure that badges and insignia are properly placed and that the uniform is worn correctly.

What About Medical Forms? A medical history for all campers is required on a yearly basis. These are the same forms as used for Summer Camp and can be re-used for NYLT. All medical forms must have been completed within one year of the end of the course, 8/10/12.

Scouts who do not pre-register may not be able to attend the conference. The course has room for only a limited number of participants. If you are thinking of attending the course, please sign up early and reserve your place with a \$50 deposit.

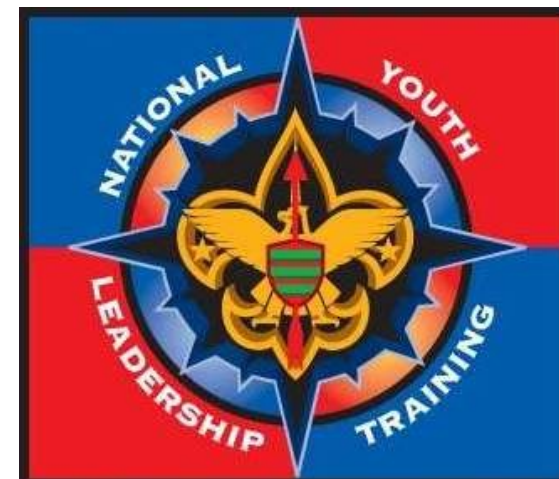

NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING CONFERENCE

Purpose: NYLT is an exciting, action-packed program that provides youth with leadership skills and experience they can use in their Troop, Crew, or Ship, and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

Course Participation Qualifications: Youth must be at least 13 years old (but not yet 18), and approved to attend by his **Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor**. He/She should be currently filling a Troop/Crew leadership position or will be, in the near future. It is expected that the Youth will have camping, cooking and hiking skills.

Location and Time: The conference will be held from August 5-10th, 2012 at Tuscarora Scout Reservation. The conference will be led by Course Director Fran Bialy and conducted by an excellent group of experienced youth and adult trainers.
